

Batona Trail Log DIARY

The idea was suggested by Dale Knappehafer. It was discussed and considered, and finally decided upon.

Jan. 20 1961 - Letter<sup>#1</sup> written to State Commissioner Salvatore A. Contempo to apprise him of our plan and obtain permission.

Jan 27, 1961 - at leaders meeting, building the trail was made an official Club project.

Feb. 10, 1961 - Reply<sup>#2</sup> received from Commissioner Contempo expressing approval of Trail project and informing us that the management of McHarton Tract and Lebanon State Forest had been asked to be helpful and that we would hear from them.

Feb. 10, 1961 - Letter<sup>#3</sup> received from Mr. J. C. MacDonald, Manager of McHarton Tract, offering cooperation and suggesting a meeting.

Feb. 18, 1961 - Letter written to Mr. Mac Donald briefly stating our plan and suggesting meeting date.

Feb. 21, 1961 - Letter received from Mr. Mac Donald setting meeting date of Sat. March 11.

Feb. 27, 1961 - Letter sent to Mr. Mac Donald acknowledging meeting date.

March 11. - Had meeting at Green Bank office. Mr. Mac Donald couldn't come. Met his assistant Mr. S. Walker. We had friendly discussion & agreed on plans.

April 13, 1961 - Letter written to Mr. Mac Donald requesting an additional meeting ~~for~~ on April 29 at Park Office.

April 17, 1961 - Reply received from Mr. Walker confirming meeting April 29.

April 29, 1961 - Meeting held with Mr. Walker. Discussed advanced details of Trail and agreed to call it Batona Trail.

May 4, 1961 - Received letter from Mr. Walker informing us that Mr. J. P. Allen, Superintendent of Lebanon would like to meet with us.

May 6, 1961 - Letter written to Mr. Allen suggesting meeting May 20.

May 8, 1961 - Letter received from Mr. Allen confirming meeting.

May 20, 1961 - Had friendly meeting meeting with Mr. Allen and discussed trail work through Lebanon State Forest.

May 26, 1961 - Received letter from Mr. Walker giving official authorization to start work on Batona Trail.

May 23, 1961 - Letter written to Mr. MacDonald mentioning meeting with Mr. Allen, and requesting official permission to begin trail work.

July 7, 1961 - Letter written to Mr. Walker to give progress report on trail work.

~~of eb~~ During March, April and May <sup>of 1961</sup> exploratory trips were made almost every weekend. This includes Dale Knapschaefer, Walt Karsznik, Paul Fischbeck and Morris Gerdock.

May 13 1961, Dale Knapschaefer and Morris Gerdock went to Chateaugay and spoke to tax collector Mr. Schieff, to obtain owners name of private property that was crossed by trail. Mr. Sloan of Chateaugay granted permission. In other area, Mr. Schieff suggested it wasn't necessary because land was cut into many parcels and owners were almost undivided for 30 years.

- Aug. 15 1961 - Letter written to Mr. Walker to give second "progress report".
- Aug. 18, 1961 Acknowledgement of "Progress Report" received from Mr. Walker.
- Aug. 19, 1961 Unscheduled meeting held with Mr. Allen of Lebanon, to discuss trail work.
- Aug. 26, 1961 Had meeting with Mr. Allen. We met Mr. Mitchell, chief Ranger of this area. He inspected our trail work in Lebanon and found it satisfactory. He and Mr. Allen agreed to build log bridges over two streams at Pekin Pond. Mr. Mitchell suggested using existing trail beyond Carpenter Spring. Dale & I checked it and found it ~~very~~ nice.
- Sept. - Jun. 3 Walt took George Sommer over route to make sketches for schedule.
- Oct. 3 1961 Letter written to Mr. Walker for meeting, to give trail mileage and discuss final details.
- Oct. 9 1961 Received answer from Mr. Walker that he couldn't meet us on 14. But suggested 21st.
- Oct. 13, 1961 Wrote to Mr. Walker that we cannot meet on 21st. (Katskill Crossing). Suggested Oct. 28.
- Oct. 28 1961 Met with Mr. Walker. Settled ~~last~~ final questions and gave mileage for signs.

Sat. Sept. 23 Morris Bardech, Al and Leo McDonald, Paul Duscheck  
(Trail measuring w/wheel)

Sat. Sept. 30. Dale Knopschofer, Walt Karsznick. (Completed trail measuring)

Sat. Oct 14 Walt, Sat & Clodens worked on stream north of Carranza.

May 13, 1961

Dab and I went to Chatworth to see Mr. Schiebe,  
the township tax assessor.

He informed us that the land from Apple Pie  
Hill to Paisley Rd. is divided into very small parcels.  
He said the owners have probably not stepped near  
their properties in 30 years. He also stated that  
the owners are almost untraceable without  
extensive research. He also assured that no one  
would know or care if we blazed through.

The trail above Paisley Rd. to the dirt road  
is owned by Mr. Sloan of Chatworth. The 3rd  
grey house before the R.R., on the right. We  
stopped there and spoke to Mrs. Sloan. She was  
very nice and told us she was sure it would be  
alright with her husband. She informed us we  
could go ahead and she <sup>would</sup> inform Mr. Sloan of it.
